

English

Throughout the Spring term, we will be exploring a visual literacy unit based on Finding Nemo. We will be writing a narrative piece, describing dialogue, action and the setting.

We will then be reading and using the text 'Iron Man' by Ted Hughes to create a character description and persuasive letter.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning multiplication and division using mental and written strategies. We will apply our knowledge to solve problems in a variety of contexts. Then, we will move onto fractions. The children will learn how to find equivalent fractions, compare and add them together.

RE

In Spring 1, we will be discussing 'How did belief in God affect the actions of people in the Old Testament?'

In Spring 2, our focus will be exploring 'What happens in churches during Lent and Easter?'

Geography

We will be learning about Rocks, Relics and Rumbles. This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity.

Science

This term, we will be learning about rocks, fossils and soil (linking to our geography learning). We will also learn about forces and magnets. This project teaches children about contact and non-contact forces, including friction and magnetism. They investigate frictional and magnetic forces, and identify parts of a magnet and magnetic materials.

D&T

In DT, we will be learning about mechanical systems and work towards creating a pop-up card.

Art

We will be focusing on ammonites. This project teaches children about artistic techniques used in sketching, printmaking and sculpture.

Computing

This term, we will be finishing our unit about programming with Scratch. We will then look at Computing systems and networks 2 – Emailing and start learning about the Computing systems and networks 3 – Journey inside a computer.

PE

This term, we will be learning how to play Netball.

MFL

In French, we will be learning playground games and numbers. We will also be learning about the French classroom and how we can describe it.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about citizenship, including rules, laws and responsibilities. We will then explore what Human Rights as well as gender stereotypes. We will also discuss what money is and how to make smart choices about money, including different types of work and jobs.
