
Reception Home Learning – Tier 1

If your child is absent for 24 - 48 hours waiting for a Covid-19 test or result and is <u>well enough</u> to complete school work, they may like to complete some of the following activities:

Tier 1

- Read regularly at home- share books together, share rhymes, retell stories and encourage your child to read aloud using any materials that they wish to explore including the reading scheme books that have been provided in their book bag. Oxford Owl provide reading materials online should you require more.
- Practise sight recognition of phonemes and high frequency words (HFW). You will find electronic copies of these on tapestry. You will receive
 hard copies, along with other blended learning resources shortly.
- Discuss the day of the week with your child and talk about any weather observations with them.
- Practise correct counting of objects and recognition of numbers daily. Sing number rhymes together.
- Please refer to the weekly note home and questions that are uploaded onto tapestry weekly. You will also be emailed copies of these on a weekly basis. This will guide you to the content that will be covered in class each week should you wish to explore this further at home.
