

Home Learning

We continue to expect daily reading, spelling practise and completion of maths consolidation tasks which will be given out weekly.

Each week your child must choose one activity to complete in their homework book


Weekly homework

In addition to the above choose ONE of these fifteen learning activities each week (suggested time to spend on it is 30 minutes)

Every week you must:

1. Learn spellings: 5 see year group list at the back of your homework book.
2. Read at home every night and write in your reading record book (15 mins).
3. Times Table Practice: 2, 5, 10 and 3 times table.
4. Maths: consolidating this week's learning - 20 mins (see separate homework sheet)

Science & Outdoor Environment (Science, PE, Healthy lifestyles, Eco issues and investigations)	What other totals can you make from these digits?	Make up your own puzzle like this.	Investigation Why material would be best for making a parachute for Flat Straley to use on his travels.
Humanities & Citizenship (RE, History, Geography, Moral & Social and Economic awareness)	Cut out magazine and catalogue pictures which show different types of materials. You may wish to take photographs of different materials you have in your home.	Always respecting others opinions.	Which special talents have you got? Write about your talents and how they help you. Think about how these may support you when you are older.
Creative Arts (Art, Design Technology, Music, drama and dance)	Create a page from a travel brochure for a place you have visited.	Research the places that you have visited. Draw them on a map or record them in a table. Maybe get a map of the world and label where you have been.	Design a new mode of transport for travelling around the world. Draw and label your design.
Remember!	Create a collage which represents you. May contain your hobbies, interests, places you have visited and your local area.	Choose a photograph from your favourite holiday or day out. Write a caption.
