Christmas Bake Off



To enter, simply bring your creation to the Bake Off stall in the Hall at the Christmas Fair. All entries must be in by 12.30pm.

Bakes will be judged in 4 categories-

- Reception and KS1 child
- KS2 child
- St Matthew's family / friend - under 14
- St Matthew's family / friend - over 14

Make sure you label your bake. Clearly label your bake, with the following:-

- Your name (*eg Prue Leith*)
- Entry group (*eg St Matthew's friend, under 14*)
- What you have baked (*eg German festive biscuits*)
- Contact phone number. (Will not be stored and would only be used to contact if a winner)

The winners will be announced later in day.

Please note that all entries are non-returnable, they will be put on the cake stall for selling once judging is over. Please make sure your bakes are on a disposable board or tray - we cannot return them to you.

Rules of Entry

1. Entry into the competition is free
2. All bakes must be presented to the Bake Off Stall no later than 12.30 on Saturday 30 November. Any entries after 12.30 will not be eligible for judging.
3. All entries must be nut-free
4. All entries are non-returnable, they will be put on the cake stall for selling once judging is over.
5. Children entering bakes can have adult assistance with their baking but we ask that the submitted bake must be mostly their own work.
6. All bakes must be clearly labelled with Bakers name, group, item baked and contact phone number. The label must be attached to the bottom of the bake, so it cannot be seen during judging.
7. The Judge's decision is final.
